

The Courtship of Giants Exhibition Access Guide

The Courtship of Giants is in the main gallery at Eastside Projects - you walk straight into the gallery when you enter the building.

The exhibition is wheelchair accessible, but there are some dead ends which you will need to reverse out of.

Guide dogs are welcome in the gallery. If you are visually impaired please talk to a member of staff who will be happy to guide you through the work. They can also offer an audio description.

Alternative formats of written and audio material are available on the front desk.

What can you expect?

- The exhibition consists of a large maze-like structure which fills the whole gallery. You walk through the maze which is made of cardboard and plaster.
- In the maze are a series of very large sculptures on tall metal armatures alongside smaller clay vessels which are mostly on the floor.
- There are metal arrows in some of the clay vessels and jutting out of some of the sculptures - please take care when moving around and do not touch.
- You will notice the smell of smoke when you enter the gallery. This is because there was a fire in the building next door. As you move through the gallery it should become weaker.
- The artwork is an immersive maze and so you can't see the way out at some points. There are a number of exits with routes out towards the front desk, if you get stuck look for the large blue-green sculpture that peeks over the top of the maze and navigate towards it.
