Traveller by Rajni Perera

Traveller is in the main gallery at Eastside Projects - you walk straight into this room when you enter the building.

What can you expect?

- This is an exhibition of painting and sculptures. At the centre of the exhibition is a large sculpture of a horse and rider surrounded by plants on the ground. There are also paintings on the walls

Disco Islam: Phantasmagoria

Disco Islam is in the second gallery at Eastside Projects.

What can you expect?

You enter the gallery through a corridor lined with silver foil streamers.

Inside the gallery there are lots of different sorts of lights - purple LED strips, coloured lights on the walls, and lights which are projecting logos on the floor.

The video is also very brightly coloured and projected at a large scale on the back wall.

There is loud sound, a combination of music and a man speaking.

There is sand on the floor.
