Look after one another. Compassion is an active and collective responsibility. To exchange ideas, listen, and learn, you must also be a caretaker in some capacity.

BE OPEN

This is a space where differences of opinion and experience can be shared. Learning can be a messy process. It will not necessarily feel comfortable, but that's ok.

DON'T ASSUME

Everyone has a different life experience and may be struggling with challenges that are not always visible. Remember that others may not have the same physical or emotional boundaries as you.

INVITE PEOPLE IN
