Check Your Privilege

Be aware of your privileges and prejudices. Acknowledge systemic racism and oppression and do what you can to dismantle it. We know we are part of the problem. This is a work in progress.

Don't Assume

Everyone has a different life experience and may be struggling with challenges that are not always visible. Remember that others may not have the same physical or emotional boundaries as you.

Be Kind

Look after one another. We're all in this space together. Caregiving is an active and collective responsibility. To exchange ideas, listen and learn you must also be a caretaker in some capacity.

Be Open

This is a space where differences of opinion and experience can be shared. Learning can be a messy process. It will not necessarily feel comfortable, but that's ok.
