

Eastside Projects Artist Fees 2024–25

Eastside Projects is committed to paying everyone we work with fairly and on time. **These are minimum rates** and depending on the nature of the work/project fees may be higher. Our fee rates are reviewed each year.

Artistic Programme - Commissions and Curated Projects	
Incidental Artists	£10,000 fee + production budget (usually up to £10,000) + £75 care package
Solo Exhibition - Main Gallery	£3000 fee + production budget (usually around £10,000) + install per diem + £75 care package
Solo Exhibition - Second Gallery	£1000 fee + production budget (usually around £1,500) + install per diem + £75 care package
Incoming Solo Exh. Existing work	£500 fee
Group Exhibitions - New Work	£500 fee + production/travel budget + install per diem + £75 care package
Group Exhibitions - Existing Work	£250 fee + travel and install per diem if needed
Performances - New Work	£500 fee + production/travel budget + £75 care package
Performances - Existing Work	£350 fee + production/travel budget
Screenings - Existing Work	£50 fee (imagined as a one off event)

Events	
Face to Face Event - Contributor fee	£200 + travel/accommodation expenses

Face to Face event - workshop facilitator/leader fee	£250 + travel/accommodation expenses
Online Event - Contributor fee	£100

Public Art Projects	
Artist Fees	Fees are project dependent and set by commissioners so we cannot identify a minimum fee. We will not work on projects which do not pay artists fairly, and will advise clients that: - Shortlisted Artists should receive a fee to develop a proposal. - Commission fees should be at least 10% of the project budget. - Artists should be paid on time according to a fee schedule and should not be financially impacted if the project timelines change significantly for reasons beyond their control. Where possible we will get this written into artists contracts.

EOP and Talent Development	
Artist Fees	EOP is an artist development programme which sits alongside our curated, artistic programme. Where fees are offered participating Artists will be paid at least the Real Living Wage.
